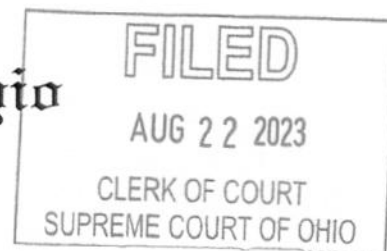


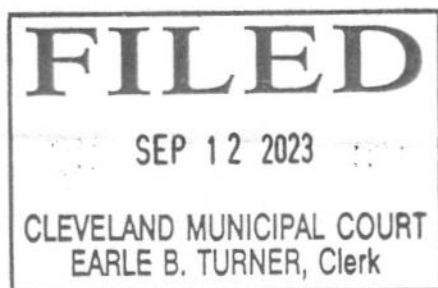

In re Disqualification of Hon. W. Moná Scott

ON AFFIDAVIT OF DISQUALIFICATION in
*City of Cleveland v. Shaker Heights Apartments
Owner, LLC, et al.*, Cleveland Municipal Court,
Housing Division, Case No. 2023-CVH-002772

Pursuant to R.C. 2701.03 and S.Ct.Prac.R. 21.01 through 21.04, the Clerk of the Supreme Court accepted for filing an affidavit seeking to disqualify Judge W. Moná Scott from the following matter: *City of Cleveland v. Shaker Heights Apartments Owner, LLC, et al.*, Cleveland Municipal Court, Housing Division, Case No. 2023-CVH-002772.

Except as provided in R.C. 2701.03(D)(2) through (4), Judge Scott is deprived of any authority to preside in the proceeding until the Chief Justice rules on the affidavit of disqualification.


Pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 21.02(A)(2), the Chief Justice orders Judge Scott to file a written response to the affidavit of disqualification. The response shall specifically and fully address, in detail, each allegation in the affidavit of disqualification.

Judge Scott shall file the response in accordance with S.Ct.Prac.R. 21.01 and 21.02 within 21 days of the date of this entry. The judge shall submit the response in letter, pleading, or affidavit format and file it in person with the Clerk, by mail or delivery service addressed to the Clerk, or by email to AOD_Filing@sc.ohio.gov.

Upon receipt by the Clerk of the judge's response, the Chief Justice will review the matter and render a written decision on the affidavit of disqualification.
