UPDATES TO THE LAW:

1. Driver license/state ID **cannot be expired**.
 - a. A suspended driver license that is not expired may be used.
 - b. Interim ID forms issued by BMV are accepted.
2. Driver license/state ID with a voter's previous address is acceptable.
3. A U.S. passport or passport card is now acceptable.
4. U.S. Military or National Guard IDs are acceptable (must include name and photo)
5. Digital (or copy) versions of ID are not acceptable, except for the Veteran ID Card (VIC) issued by the Department of Veteran Affairs.

TO VOTE BY MAIL:

- You **can** use a shelter address to receive your application and ballot.
- For your vote to be counted, the completed ballot must be **postmarked no later than Nov. 3**.
- Or, return it in person at the Board of Elections before 7:30pm on Nov. 4.
